Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs)

1. Do I need a floor groove for this guide?

Yes. While the guide mounts to the wall, the roller typically travels within a 12mm x 16mm (Width x Depth) groove routed into the bottom of the wooden door. This keeps the guide completely invisible.

2. Can this be used for glass doors?

This specific set (057.3128.171) is designed for wooden doors. For glass sliding systems, Hawa offers specialised glass guides (e.g., Art No. 053.3191.901) that include plastic sliders to protect the glass surface.

3. Is this guide suitable for "Pocket Doors"?

Absolutely. It is the preferred choice for pocket door installations where floor access inside the wall cavity is restricted.

Installation Tip

For doors wider than 1200 mm, HAWA recommends using a continuous bottom guide rail in conjunction with this roller set to ensure maximum stability across the entire travel distance.²
