



## Penny End T Hinge – 18" – Pair – Pewter

**Variant code: 33656**

When opened a tee hinge has the appearance of a letter 'T'.

- An alternative to butt hinges, tee hinges are usually used in conjunction with a suffolk latch on traditional plank doors.
- Designed to match our bean thumbblatches and d handles.
- A pair and a half (3 hinges) can be fitted to provide extra strength for heavier doors.
- Our blacksmith tee hinges are hammered into shape from mild steel using the traditional manufacturing method of an anvil and fire.
- Supplied as a pair.
- Supplied with matching SS wood screws.
